## **Program Purpose**

To provide an easily recognizable method for law enforcement officials to enforce parking restrictions and ensure that designated parking zones remain available for the use and convenience of those people with the greatest need.

## **Eligibility**

Any person presenting proof of eligibility for long or short term parking privileges as certified by a physician is entitled to participate in the Disabled Persons Placard Program.

## **General Information**

- Placards expire on the date indicated.
- Individuals issued disabled persons licence plates for use on their vehicle are subject to the yearly registration fee. If vehicles are currently registered with regular licence plates, an exchange may be made by any authorized Registry Agent. Licence plates must be renewed annually to maintain validity.
- Only passenger vehicles registered in the name of the disabled individual or jointly registered by the disabled individual are eligible for disabled persons licence plates.
- Visitors to Alberta who are disabled may apply for a short term disabled persons placard.

## **Registry Agent Office**

- You may apply for a Disabled Persons Placard at any Registry Agent office.
